College Scholarship Fund: First Mennonite offers financial assistance to students who attend an Anabaptist/Mennonite college or university. Scholarships are matched dollar-for-dollar by the institutions up to \$1,000, matching 25% above that amount. Scholarships for 2019-20 school year were increased to \$1,500/student/year because funds were available. Eight students are currently receiving FMC scholarships.

- *Students currently attending or considering attending a Mennonite college in 2020-21 should contact Louise Matthews (matthewsa@bluffton.edu) by Sunday, Nov. 24. Final college decisions need not be made until spring but Dec. 1 is the deadline to guarantee matching funds.
- *The "College Scholarship Fund" is dependent on your generous financial support and contributions may be designated as such. Participating students for 2020-21 will receive \$1,000 from FMC for the year unless sufficient funds are available to again offer \$1,500.

The Bluffton University International Student Assistance Fund was established by Paul Neufeld Weaver, Lori Nester and Ivan Friesen to make funds available to international students when needs arise. Carrie Mast has also been involved in assisting with overseeing the fund. Donations may be made by writing a check to First Mennonite Church and designating ISAF.
